Accessibility Access Project Update



A number of design/build firms have been contacted and discussions held concerning our preferred design concept. We look forward to receiving their design proposals including preliminary pricing range estimates for our consideration in the coming weeks. Once received, these proposals will be reviewed and it is hoped that a preferred submission can be selected and subsequently brought to the congregation for consideration before the end of 2017.

Assuming that there is support for the proposed design, we could enter contract negotiations leading to a contract award, creation of the drawing package and acquisition of the necessary permits and variances followed by construction in mid-2018.

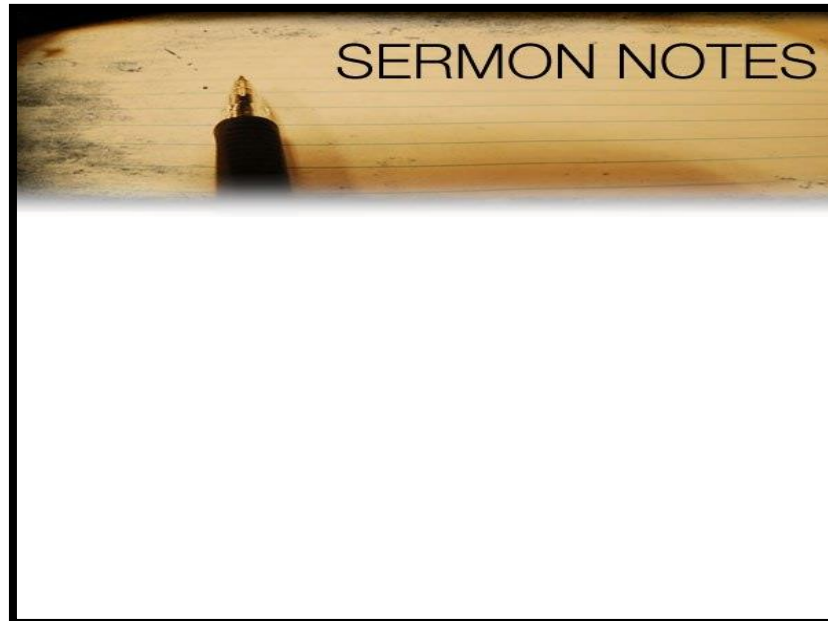
